The Office of Professional Development of the Project Executive Group is pleased to offer its **Eric Jenett Advanced Strategic Project Management Program** in collaboration with PMI Houston Chapter during 2009.

This program was co-founded by Eric Jenett, co-founder of PMI and first PMP - Certificate No. 1, over a decade ago. His idea was to develop an advanced project management training program for experienced project managers. He believed it needed to be in an academic setting at the graduate level but practical in application. The result—advanced training for experienced Project Developers and Managers. It was originally developed for delivering advanced training to experienced project managers while providing them with contact hours for PMP re-certification.

Formerly The Advanced Project Management Program at Rice University's Jones Graduate School of Management — Executive Education, it is now sponsored by the Project Management Institute (PMI) Houston Chapter and is a legacy from the decade-old joint venture between PMI Houston and Rice University. This is the first year the program has been offered in Houston outside of Rice University due to retirement of the co-founder and Professor, Paul Allen. Paul now brings it to the PMIH Chapter.

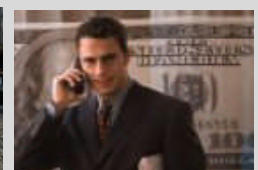

His education includes the US Merchant Marine Academy (Class of 1969); graduate work in Transportation Management at the State University of New York; MBA (1996) at Rice University' and Ph.D. research in Change Management at the University of Wales, Cardiff.
